
The Art of Strength: Karate's Rising Stars

Scientific and Educational Development: Nehru established many institutions like IITs, AIIMS, and ISRO, focusing on science, technology, and education to shape India's future.


His legacy continues through his focus on secularism, development, and nurturing future generations.

FIELD TRIP TO THE CHILDREN'S TRAFFIC PARK

A MEMORABLE EXPERIENCE FOR GRADE 5 STUDENTS

Field trips are an essential part of experiential learning, and on 22 NOV 2024, the Grade 5 students of RATHINAM INTERNATIONAL PUBLIC SCHOOL embarked on an exciting educational visit to the Children's Traffic Park. This carefully planned excursion aimed to educate the students about traffic rules, road safety, and the importance of being responsible citizens while providing them with an opportunity to explore and learn outside the classroom.

INTRODUCTION

The day began with an interactive session conducted by the park's traffic safety instructors. They used child-friendly language and engaging demonstrations to introduce the students to basic traffic rules. Key topics covered included:

- The meaning of traffic signals (red, yellow, and green lights).
- Importance of wearing seatbelts while traveling in cars
- How to safely cross roads using zebra crossings.
- Significance of road signs like "No Parking," "Stop," & "Speed Limits."
- The dangers of jaywalking and distracted driving.

PRACTICAL DEMONSTRATIONS

The instructors then moved on to practical demonstrations using the park's mini road setups. The students were divided into small groups and actively participated in:

- Acting as pedestrians, learning to cross the roads responsibly.
- Riding bicycles and mini scooters to understand how drivers must follow traffic rules.
- Observing the proper functioning of traffic lights and roundabouts.

The hands-on approach ensured that the students not only understood but also remembered these vital lessons.

ROLE-PLAYING AND FUN ACTIVITIES

To make the learning experience more enjoyable, the children participated in role-playing activities. Some students took on the roles of traffic police officers, while others acted as drivers or pedestrians.

This tour highlighted the importance of infrastructure in road safety and gave the students a better understanding of how traffic systems work in real life.




12TH NATIONAL LEVEL DRAWING COMPETITION




VISITED COCOPEAT AND COIRS MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY, NEGAMAM


